Siam Park was born from a bold vision to create the ultimate water park experience on Tenerife. Inaugurated in **2008**, it quickly established itself as the largest water theme park in Europe, covering 18.5 hectares of lush, tropical landscape. The project was driven by German businessman Wolfgang Kiessling, who aimed to blend technological innovation with immersive design. Within less than a decade, the park managed to combine cutting-edge engineering with a rich Thai-inspired narrative that captivates visitors from around the world.

The park's rapid rise to fame was fueled by its record-breaking attractions and meticulous attention to detail. It has been named the number one water park in the world nine times in a row, a testament to its consistent excellence. With over **1.27 million visitors** in 2024 alone, Siam Park has become a cornerstone of Canarian tourism. Its success lies not just in its slides, but in the seamless integration of relaxation zones, family areas, and adrenaline-pumping rides that cater to every type of guest.

Architecturally, the park is a masterpiece of thematic immersion. Every structure, from the towering freefall slide to the gentle lazy river, is designed to evoke the spirit of Thailand. The use of vibrant colors, exotic vegetation, and intricate details creates an atmosphere that feels both authentic and fantastical. Today, it stands as a global leader in water park design, attracting millions of guests who come to experience the perfect balance of thrill, relaxation, and cultural immersion under the warm sun of Tenerife.

VISIT DURATION

Navigating the Park Zones

Adrenaline Zone

This area is home to the park's most intense rides, including the Tower of Power and The Volcano. Here, you'll find freefall slides and high-speed coasters that test your courage. The structures are towering and dramatic, set against a backdrop of lush greenery. It's the place to go if you're looking for a heart-pounding experience.

Family & Relax Zone

Designed for all ages, this zone features safe water playgrounds like The Lost City and Coco Beach. Gentle slides and wave pools allow children to play without height restrictions. Families can unwind together in a relaxed setting, enjoying the calm waters and shaded areas. It's a perfect spot for bonding and taking a break from the thrill.

Landscape & River Zone

The Mai Thai River winds through this zone, offering a soothing journey amidst lush vegetation. At the end, you pass through a tunnel-aquarium, adding an element of surprise to the slow ride. This area is ideal for unwinding after the slides, providing a peaceful contrast to the high-energy zones. The natural beauty here enhances the overall park experience.

01

Adrenaline Zone

Tower of Power

The main attraction plunges visitors into a tunnel passing under an aquarium containing sharks after a 28-meter drop. This underground passage creates a moment of suspense and awe. The combination of height and darkness makes it a standout experience. It's a must-do for anyone seeking extreme thrills.

💡 The **shark tunnel** section is particularly famous for its eerie lighting and close-up views of marine life, adding a unique twist to the standard freefall ride.

02

Family Zone

The Wave Palace

Produces the largest artificial waves in the world, reaching 3 meters high. This technical feat transforms the pool into a true miniature ocean. Swimmers can enjoy the sensation of riding real waves in a controlled environment. It's a popular spot for both families and solo adventurers.

💡 The **3-meter waves** are generated by advanced hydraulic systems that mimic natural ocean conditions, ensuring a realistic surfing experience for all skill levels.

03

Relax Zone

Mai Thai River

A slow river amidst lush vegetation, offering a passage through a tunnel-aquarium at the end. It includes some rapids for added excitement. This is the ideal space to unwind after the slides. The journey takes about 40 minutes, providing a soothing break in the middle of the park.

💡 The **tunnel-aquarium** at the end of the river allows guests to see fish swimming overhead, creating a magical underwater effect as they float along.

Adrenaline Zone

Singha

Offers water roller coasters on 2-person rafts, featuring cold showers. This progressive build-up culminates in tight turns and dizzying drops. It provides a refreshing challenge for thrill-seekers. The ride combines speed and surprise elements effectively.

💡 The **cold showers** are strategically placed to catch riders off guard, adding an element of humor and surprise to the high-speed descent.

Family Zone

The Lost City

A dedicated area for children with safe waterfalls and no height limits. Kids can have fun without any restrictions. The lush vegetation adds to the playful atmosphere. It's a favorite spot for families to watch the waves while enjoying a peaceful stay.

💡 The **safe waterfalls** are designed with soft landing areas, ensuring that young children can splash and play without risk of injury.

Relax Zone

Siam Beach

Offers a perfect artificial beach to rest under the palm trees. Away from the buzz of the slides, it's a quiet retreat. Families love watching the waves while enjoying the sun. It's the favorite spot for relaxation and socializing.

💡 The **palm trees** provide natural shade, making it a comfortable spot to lounge and soak up the atmosphere without feeling exposed to the sun.

Adrenaline Zone

Kinnaree

A 200-meter hybrid ride water slide that combines multiple types of slides. It offers a varied experience with different speeds and angles. Riders can enjoy a long, continuous journey. It's a great option for those who want variety in their thrill.

💡 The **hybrid design** allows for a seamless transition between different slide types, keeping riders engaged throughout the entire 200-meter course.

Relax Zone

Sea Lion Island

Features a sea lion pool near the entrance of the park. Guests can observe these friendly marine animals up close. It's a charming addition to the park's wildlife offerings. The interactive aspect makes it a hit with children and adults alike.

💡 The **sea lions** are trained to perform playful tricks, delighting visitors with their intelligence and charm during scheduled shows.

TIPS

Tips for the Perfect Day

TIMING

Arrive right at opening to access flagship attractions like the Tower of Power without queues. Weekday mornings outside school holidays are generally the least crowded.

BILLET

Book in advance, especially in summer and during school holidays. Compare prices across different sites and check for discounts for families or residents.

PARCOURS

Use the official park app to check real-time wait times and optimize your route. Target free attractions and avoid endless queues by planning your path strategically.

PHOTO

The best light for photos is found in the early morning or late afternoon, when the low sun illuminates the Thai structures. Avoid midday hours when shadows make faces difficult to capture.

PAUSE

Consider having lunch early, around 12:30, to avoid long queues at dining areas. Bringing a light picnic for the children can save time and money.

ENFANTS

Check the specific size and age requirements for each attraction to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for kids. The Lost City and Sawasdee are ideal for younger children.

AUDIOGUIDE

While an audioguide is not specified, downloading the official app provides essential information and wait times. Focus on using it to navigate efficiently rather than for detailed audio commentary.

CONFORT

Bring your own padlock for lockers if possible, as they are available for an extra fee. Wear comfortable shoes suitable for wet surfaces and bring a change of clothes.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

FAQ

Which ticket should I choose for Siam Park?

The standard ticket is enough to access all attractions. Choose a skip-the-line pass if you want to minimize queues during peak times. Always check the exact ticket contents before purchasing.

Do I really need to book in advance?

Yes, advance booking is strongly recommended especially in summer and during school holidays. It guarantees your entry and often provides preferential rates compared to on-site purchase.

Can I cancel my ticket?

The cancellation policy depends on the type of ticket purchased and when the request is made. Many options offer free cancellation up to 24 hours before the scheduled date, but check the specific terms of your ticket.

Are there multi-day tickets?

Multi-day pass options are sometimes available depending on the season. They allow you to visit the park multiple times over a given period, ideal if you're staying long in Tenerife.

How long does it take to visit Siam Park?

Allow a full day to fully enjoy the park. It's vast and takes time to go through major attractions like Tower of Power and relaxing moments on Mai Thai River, not to mention the shaded rest areas.
